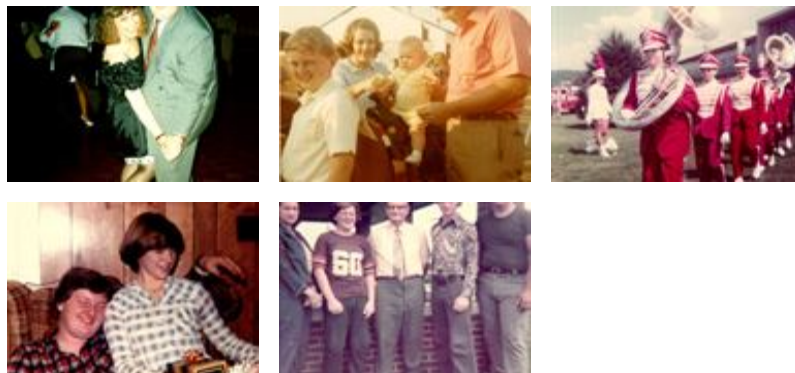

Beyond his exceptional work, Brent was an even more remarkable person. He had an open-door policy and a compassionate ear for anyone who needed to confide in him. Jesus Christ was the centerpiece of his life, and he beamed with pride speaking of his

children and grandchildren. His unwavering Christian faith shone through in his kindness and integrity.

His generosity, his brilliance, and his compassion will forever live on through all those he so profoundly touched.
