



Brian Allen Midkiff

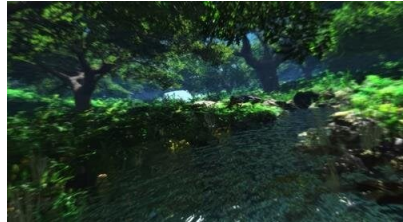
September 12, 1965 - July 3, 2016
