On January 17, 2025, Christine Rowe, age 85, passed away peacefully and joined her savior, Jesus Christ, and her husband of 66 years, Flem Dennis Rowe, whom she was lost without. The days prior to her passing were filled with visits from family and friends who reminisced about precious times together.
