Clyde Dobey, Jr, 91 of Huntington, WV, went home to be with his Lord on Thursday, December 16, 2021 at the Emogene Dolin Jones Hospice House in Huntington, WV. He was born February 24, 1930 in Huntington, WV, son of the late Clyde and Anna Moore Dobey, Sr. Clyde's Christian experience began with his baptism at a young age many years ago at Calvary Baptist Church under Rev. L.R. Walker. Clyde was a 1948 graduate of Douglas High School.
