September 28, 1925 - October 24, 2018

Clyde E. Whited, 93, of Huntington, WV went to his eternal home to be with the Lord on October 24, 2018. This obituary was written several years ago by Clyde and given to his daughters to keep until his death.

I was born in Gay, WV on September 28, 1925 to Rev. C.D. Whited and Dollie G. Fields Whited. I had three siblings; a sister, Audrey N. Williams and brothers, Clarence C. Whited and Golden Ree Whited.; all who have preceded me in death. It was a privilege to be born into this family (the best ever). It was under my dad's preaching, I accepted the Lord as my Savior.
