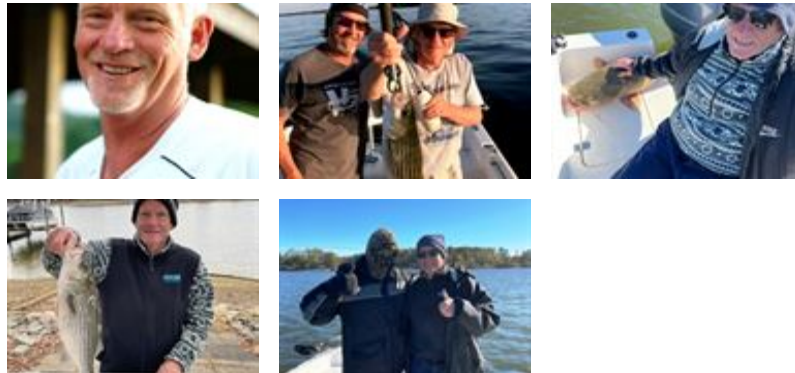

“ *The Fitzwaters and Reeds were next door neighbors right across Pea Ridge from Henson Mortuary. Dale and I were childhood friends in that wonderful neighborhood. My dad had a steel basketball frame erected behind our house. There were games going on all day long.
