“Mr./Coach Costello was one of the best teachers and mentors I had growing up as a student athlete at South Point High School. He was a very good teacher of mathematics, plenty enough for me to waive entrance exams up to Calculus at Berea College in 1987, and a very caring coach. He, along with Coach Les Delong, took the Pointers to multiple matches and tournaments (we also had one at our own school), a dynasty of winning often, unparalleled in the tri-state area at that time. We even had to travel further for better/stronger competition to help us into the post season. One of our strongest showings was winning the Nitro Tournament in the first 2 rounds with every single wrestler advancing to the semifinals, and all but one by pins, plus additional ones traveled to in Cincinnati, Cleveland, etc. It is good to know that he trusted Jesus as his savior and re-mentioned this again in Florida when I went down to visit him a few years ago while visiting my adopted son's family in Edgewater and my uncle in Tamarac; that was the summer of 2009 or 2010, if I remember correctly. I took him to Texas Roadhouse for dinner, the least of what I could do for him after contributing so much to my life. He bought me my first pair of wrestling shoes in 9th grade, knowing that would be a financial strain on my parents, who were taking care to two mentally and physically handicapped boys.

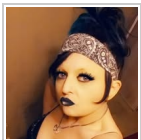
