July 20, 1929 - February 12, 2025

It is with profound sadness but in loving memory that we announce the passing of Evadeen Yoak Kesler, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister, and friend, who passed away peacefully on February 12th, 2025, at the age of 95. Born on July 20th, 1929, in Grantsville WV, Evadeen was the daughter of the late Elias and Ollie Yoak. She grew up in Calhoun County, WV where she adored the farm life with her family. She was known for her humor, generosity, intelligence, and kind, caring strength. She had a profound impact on everyone who knew her. She served in the US Airforce from May 21st, 1951, through January 10th, 1956, as a 1st Lieutenant during the Korean War. She graduated first from St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing, and then from Charity Hospital of Louisiana at New Orleans as a Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA). She has "lovingly" made it known a few times she carried a higher rank in the Airforce than her husband, Gordon. Evadeen dedicated her life to family, nursing, Marshall Athletics, gardening, and her friends and neighbors. She was preceded in death by her husband Gordon Kesler – you didn't see one without the other -- son and daughter in law Gordon Dale (Sharon) Kesler, sister Grace (Woodrow) Richards, brothers, Norman (Leona) Yoak, Ray (survived by Madeline) Yoak, and Joe Yoak. She is survived by her brother Robert (the late Delores) Yoak, and sisters Edna Robinson, and Hazel (Ray) Tingler. Evadeen was a devoted mother to Bruce (Penny) Kesler, a proud grandmother to Kristye Shaffer, Stephanie (Jason) Easter, Drew Kesler, Kourtnei Kesler and great grandmother to Will Shaffer,

Heidi Settle, Jude Settle, and Kate Kesler. Her love for cooking, reading, spending time outdoors, and Marshall Athletics was only surpassed by her unwavering dedication to her family. 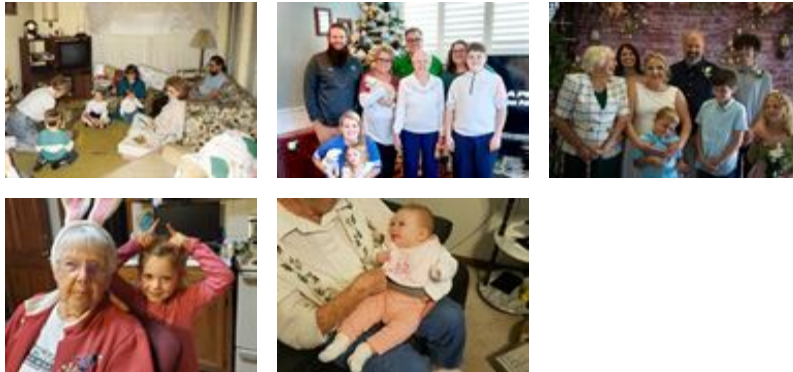
