



Flem Dennis Rowe

September 10, 1939 - March 30, 2024

On March 30, 2024, Flem Dennis Rowe, age 84, passed away peacefully while holding the hand of his beloved wife of nearly 66 years. Flem was born September 10, 1939, the son of the late Dewey and Rhoda Ann Rowe of East Lynn, West Virginia. He is survived by his wife, Christine Davidson Rowe; their three children: Dennis Larry Rowe, Robin Rowe Creasy (Greg), and Mark Allen Rowe (Kristen); seven grandchildren: Kristina Zucchini (Paul), Bethany Bickerton (Zack), Jessica Vogt (Jimmy), Edwin Reyes (Ilgin), Ian Rowe, Allen "AJ" Rowe, and Andrew Rowe; nine great-grandchildren: Sakinah, Ellie, Amir, Ethan, Aliyah, Evan, Ali, Otto, and Milo; and a sister Freda Moon (Frank). Flem was a quiet, unassuming man who rarely spoke of worldly accomplishments. It was his example that spoke volumes. He lived his faith daily and encouraged his family to do the same.
