Rev. Frederick Eugene "Fred" Kitchen, 77 of Huntington, WV was escorted by angels to his heavenly home on Thursday, December 30, 2021, in Cabell Huntington Hospital. He was born February 14, 1944, in Huntington, WV the son of the late, Leonard Kitchen and Avis Blankenship Kitchen Adkins. He also had a weekly ministry radio broadcast on WEMM Radio for several years called Heartbeat Radio Program. He retired from BASF Chemical with 35 years of service, was a graduate of Huntington East High School and later operated the World Missionary Evangelism Food Pantry in the Guyandotte section of Huntington. He was also an amazing basketball player in his younger years.

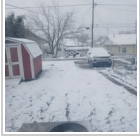

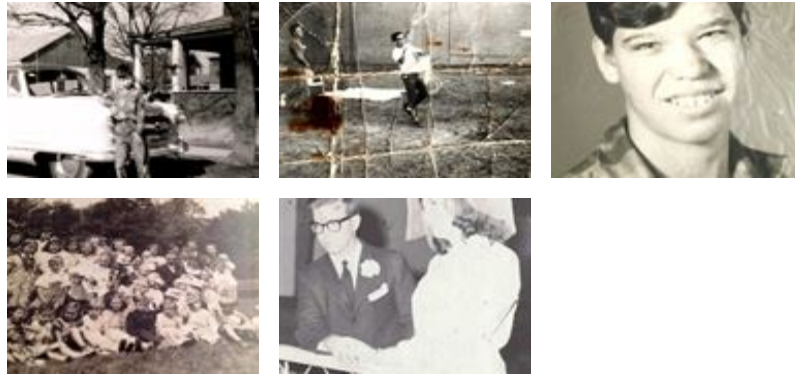
