George Tracy Jones, 86, peacefully left his earthly home on October 8, 2023, and is now reunited in heaven with his beloved wife, Barbara. He will be greatly missed by his family, including his son Tracy and wife Amy of Richmond, VA; his son Troy of Huntington, WV, and daughter Jennifer and her partner Terry George of Charleston, WV. He leaves behind many friends and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. Born in Huntington in 1937, Tracy was one of four children of Tracy and Princess Jones. He was predeceased by his brother, Robert Mays, sister, Joan Davidson, and leaves behind his brother, Max Mays. He also leaves behind a special sister in law, Joan Meredith, who helped him so much over the years, especially during his illness. Tracy went to Otterbein University where he played various sports, and also attended Marshall University. He served his country honorably in the United States Army. After college, he co-owned local restaurants, Tracy's Pizza, with his father before embarking on a long career as a Sales Engineer with Goulds Pumps and ITT Industries. After retiring, he spent most of his time volunteering at the First United Methodist Church, and the local food pantry, where he always wanted those less fortunate to not go hungry. When not volunteering, he could usually be found lending a helping hand to his neighbors – often without being asked, or attending his grandchildren's sporting events. A visitation will be held on
