September 21, 1923 - December 1, 2012

Mr. John Wesley Chapman, 89, of Gallatin, TN, formerly of Huntington, WV, passed away on December 1, 2012. He was born in Glenwood, WV, to Lewis E. Chapman and Zelma Griffis Chapman, one of seven children. Mr. Chapman was preceded in death by his loving wife, Naomi Alene Chapman, of 69 years.
