Lindsay Joel Cogar, 54, of Huntington, passed away Monday December 8, 2014 at his residence. He was born August 20, 1960, in Cabell County, a son of the late Tom A. Cogar, and Jane Maralee Cogar of Milton. He was a 1978 graduate of Milton High School, and attended Marshall University. Lindsay was a talented and creative chef, having been head sous chef for a hotel in Amarillo, TX, then managing many restaurants in his career, including The Petite Cafe in Lazarus for several year Lindsay traveled the Eastern Caribbean, serving as a yacht pilot for an inter-island transportation service in St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands He then worked with the Boilermakers Union, and volunteered many hours of his time with the American Legion. He was a member of the Sons of the American Legion Post 177 in Barboursville, WV, serving on the Board, and also formerly serving as Chaplain.
