And I shall fade from earth forever.*

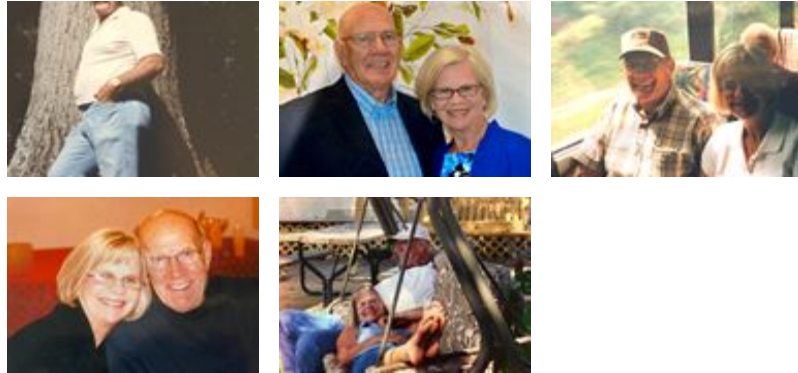
