



Randal Thomas Bell

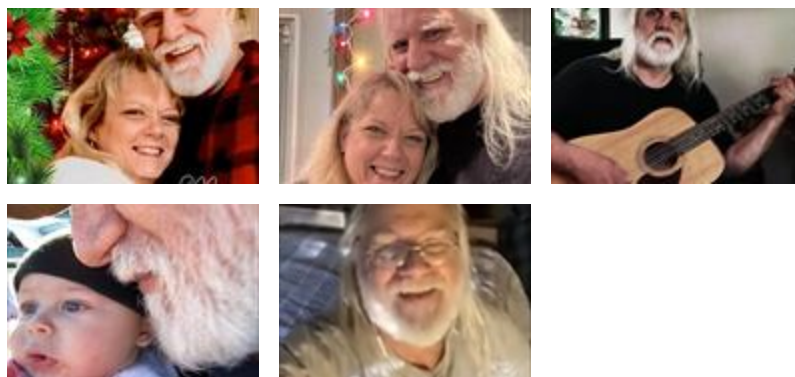
