



## Willa Eileen Romine

December 6, 1918 - September 1, 2010

Willa Eileen Romine, age 91, of Springfield, Oh., formerly of Huntington, W.Va., went home to be with her Savior on Wednesday, September 1, 2010. Funeral services will be conducted at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 4, 2010 at Grace Gospel Church, Huntington with Pastor Jerry Matt officiating. Burial will follow in White Chapel Memorial Gardens in Barboursville, W.Va. Eileen was born on December 6, 1918 in Oklahoma City, OK the fifth of eight children to parents Theodore Franklin and Carrie (Ferguson) Hatfield. When Eileen was a young girl, the family returned to their roots in West Virginia where Eileen lived out most of her life. Eileen was a godly woman, wife, and mother. During her life she was a well-known children's Sunday School, VBS, and Pioneer Girls teacher. She was also an excellent gardener, creative problem-solver and, perhaps due to having five brothers, very good at sports.
